

Non-Member Sign Up Options for CPYC Youth Sailing

There are three mechanisms in place to provide non full-member participants with introductory access to the CPYC Youth Sailing program. Participants may select which one of these discounted programs best applies to their family. Usage of a discounted program is limited to first season only and additional seasons of sailing require that a parent be a CPYC member.

1) Grandparent Rule:

Children whose grandparents are current members in good standing of CPYC may sail in the Program for their first year under the grandparents' membership.

2) Pilot Program:

Any non-CPYC member child may participate in the summer youth sailing program administered by the Youth Sailing Committee with the following restrictions and conditions:

- · Not more than 25 non-member participants can be enrolled in the season
- · All participants' legal guardians must sign the appropriate waiver of liability.
- · A participant's immediate family member may not have had membership standing in the 3 years preceding April 30 of the year of the Youth Sailing season.
- · Youth Sailing Program costs are detailed in the "YS Pricing Matrix" link available on our webpage at https://www.cpyc.org/youth-sailing/
- \cdot An additional participation fee of \$175.00 is charged to each non-member family. Payment of this fee entitles participants in the program to access to the CPYC during Youth Sailing events.
- · Applications must be submitted by June 1 of the season.
- · Applications and participation are subject to approval by the Youth Sailing Committee.

3) Trial Membership:

CPYC offers trial memberships that provide full access to the CPYC for 1 year for \$625. The price includes \$125 of "Chits" that could be spent on food and beverage in the Pilothouse. For additional information on *Trial Membership* email membership@cpyc.org
